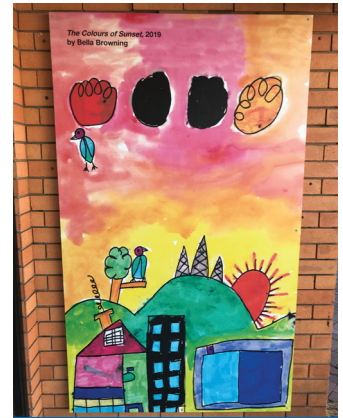


The Gap Ward Primary and Secondary School Art Competition
